Information on the teaching seminar in Opole

The first teaching seminar organized in the framework of the TEMTIS project took place in Opole, Poland on 28.3.2008. It was organized by the Technical University of Opole.

The aim of the seminar was to provide test teaching of the prepared materials to a selected local audience. The selected materials were Handbook 1 and Case studies. The language of instruction was English.

The speakers of the seminar were: P.Kuklík (CTU Prague), A.S.Hansen (Horsens), M.Premrov (U.of Maribor), A.Lokaj (VSB-TUO) and A.Marynowicz (TU Opole).

All speakers had two presentations – one was a chapter from Handbook 1 and an example of case study they worked on.

The audience consisted of students of the Faculty of Civil Engineering of TU Opole, project partners and lecturers from TU Opole. The students expressed their feedback from the seminar on questionnaires. According to the evaluation the seminar was considered well prepared and the presentations were interesting and useful.

The presentations proved that the teaching materials are well prepared and can be useful to be used both at universities and for self-study.

Apart from the seminar most of the project partner participants took part in an excursion to a wooden church in Krzyzanovice and a wooden open-air museum one day before the seminar.

Next teaching seminar will take place in Prague in June 2008.
